Logline

A suicidal man is forced to face his demons when he falls for his new neighbor, an attractive young woman who won't stop knocking on his door.

Short Synopsis

In this charming dark comedy, a man struggles with agoraphobia, social anxiety disorder and depression. Oh, and his fiancée is dead. When an outgoing young woman moves in down the hall, she may just be the one to force him out of his misery. But letting go isn't so easy for Greg.

Long Synopsis (20 lines)

Meet Greg, a writer struggling with agoraphobia, social anxiety disorder, and depression. His dog has passed away. Oh, his fiancée is dead too. Greg's life has all but lost its sense of meaning, and nothing he writes gives him any sense of closure, or escape from his past either. He lives alone, opening his door only to pick up the day's food delivery.

This is until he sees Emily, an outgoing young woman, who has just moved into the apartment across the hall. She is eager to get to know some new people in the building, and approaches Greg, having bought some cookies to share. Needless to say, her first attempt is unsuccessful. It's going to take more than cookies for Greg to open up to Emily, but it is a start.

While Greg cannot understand it, there is something about his new neighbor that fascinates him. And she doesn't give up easily either, knocking again on his door. This time, he lets her in, getting a small glimpse into Greg's world, and his past. She wants to see him again, and invites him to her place for dinner.

Emily's arrival is a breath of fresh air for Greg, forcing him to see his life differently, and slowly work to pick himself up. He is excited about having dinner with her; it's the start of something new! Until he opens his apartment door, and realizes, that he does still have agoraphobia, and social anxiety disorder, and depression. Oh, and his

fiancée is dead.

Will Greg be able to gather enough strength to make it to Emily's door, or will his one opportunity to begin anew in his life, leaving his past behind him, be too much to handle?

Greg Winter – Greg

Greg Winter was born into a military family in Concord, MA. Winter began his career in Chicago, Illinois, where he performed in commercials and theater and was active in the improv community. He's most recognized for his role as Cody Kurtzman in the acclaimed Showtime series, THE CHRIS ISAAK SHOW. He received a BA in theatre from Western Michigan University.

Angela Gulner – Emily

Angela Gulner earned her MFA in Acting from the American Repertory Theater/Moscow Art Theatre School Institute for Advanced Theater Training at Harvard University. Since graduation, she has worked steadily in theater, film, and television in LA. Recent credits include "Glee", "Strings" produced by James Franco, and "Grayson: Earth One", Nightwing webseries gone viral.

Eric Yang - Writer and Director

Hollywood screenwriter Scott Frank (GET SHORTY, MINORITY REPORT) has praised Eric's work at the AFI Conservatory as "bold," and producer Ted Griffin (OCEAN'S ELEVEN, MATCHSTICK MEN) spoke highly of his most recent film, calling it "impressive." Nikit Doshi - Producer

Nikit hails from Kenya, and after living there for 18 years; he pursued an undergraduate degree in film production in Perth, Australia. Most recently, Nikit was co-producer of SILK, directed by Catherine Dent (THE SHIELD), and starring Oscar®-nominee Shohreh Aghdashloo (THE HOUSE OF SAND AND FOG). He has worked on various films in Australia, wildlife photography projects in Kenya and Tanzania, and on two major Bollywood films, OM SHANTI OM (with Shahrukh Khan) and SORRY BHAI. Nikit is currently working with Captivate Entertainment, producers of THE BOURNE TRILOGY, and at MGM, the studio that gave us SKYFALL and THE HOBBIT.

Edward Salerno Jr. – Director of Photography

Edward graduated in 2009 from Fairleigh Dickinson University with a B.A. in Film and a Minor in Cinematography. His impressive work at the university earned him an award for Outstanding Achievement in Film. He has worked as director of photography, gaffer, camera operator, and first assistant camera on various shows, from commercials to music videos. His films have been showcased at New York's ACEFEST, South Side Film Festival, and Urban Suburban Film Festival
