Jan Bezouška was born in Prague, Czech Republic, at the end of the Communist regime; he was four years old when the Czech nation experienced the Velvet Revolution, and is part of the first generation of students with the sanctioned opportunity to study abroad and experience Western cultures. From a young age, Jan was surrounded by multimedia arts: his mother is a Czech actress who emerged from the famed acting school DAMU; she presently teaches at DAMU and is a regular presence on TV shows and commercials in Prague. Jan's father graduated from Czech's famed Film School FAMU and was named one of the top Czech Creative Directors in Advertising being the first Czech person to win a Gold Lion at Cannes. He is also a writer for film/television and teaches advertising at Charles University in Prague.

In 2008, Jan received his BcA in Film Production from the Film Academy of Miroslav Ondricek in Pisek, Czech Republic. He then moved to North America to attend West Virginia State University, where he earned a Master of Arts in Communications & Media Studies. In 2014, Jan graduated from the USC School of Cinematic Arts with an MFA in Film & TV Production, with a specialization in Sound Design and Mixing. While at USC, Jan also served as an assistant sound instructor for graduate and undergraduate courses. His professional mentors at USC include Don Hall, Richard Burton, and Stephen Flick.

Since moving to the United States, Jan has worked on numerous short films, commercials, documentaries, and features, including the award winning films FRUITVALE STATION (Ryan Coogler, 2013) and LAKE LOS ANGELES (Mike Ott, 2014).
