She is in the editing phases of a documentary she has directed and produced, *How Old is Old*, which features Judge Judy, Tony Curtis, Doris Roberts and Tony Bennett. Ms. Gorcey just completed a documentary *One Song* and pre-production on *Convicted2 Love*.

Ms. Gorcey raised hundreds of thousand of dollars from folks like Geffen Records, Southern California Edison, Mattel Foundation, etc., for LAC+USC County Medical Center, which was one hospital facility she ran *Caring Strokes*.
