FILMMAKER STATEMENT

The inspiration for LATCHED came from a desire to produce something uniquely beautiful and shocking involving immediate family and cherished friends. A new type of genre film, Latched was designed to dance between the frightening and the artistic. Written specifically for my wife (Alana Elmer) and 14-month-old son (Bowen), this story could only be told with the honest dynamic of a mother and son whose real relationship lures the viewer deeper into an unexpected nightmare.

As a professional dancer, Alana performed with the Toronto Dance Theatre for 12-years. After Bowen was born, both Alana and I felt a desire to create a new project combining her life-long passion for dance with my filmmaking obsession. Little did we know, shooting Latched in late November on a remote Island with a toddler would prove to be a mission teeming with hilarious and frustrating challenges. The actual making of Latched would demand an unexpected level of creative endurance from everyone involved.

school, cinematographer Stuart Cameron and I enrolled in a "Communications technology" course taught by Mr. Dale Andrews. Dale introduced Stuart and I to the world of visual storytelling and guided us both into our professional careers. In 2016 after countless collaborations, Dale joined the Latched team as Executive Producer to help ensure that the film was brought to life with the same passion and energy that sparked their obsession with filmmaking almost two-decades earlier.

Rob Brunner (Co-director) and I have worked together on a variety of shows including the Amazing Race Canada where we would travel the globe constantly dreaming up outlandish story ideas for our future films. In 2015 we decided to join forces and establish a unique filmmaking outfit known as "Bokeh Collective". An entertainment company specializing in epic storytelling with cutting-edge production value. LATCHED represents our first effort as a directing duo and the quality of entertainment we are truly excited to produce.

JUSTIN HARDING WRITER & DIRECTOR

Justin is a multi-award winning Filmmaker and Television Showrunner. After a decade directing a wide variety of TV series, Justin continued as a Producer on many of the highest-rated series in Canada including The Amazing Race Canada, MasterChef Canada, Canada's Smartest Person, Home to Win, Canada's Worst Driver and many more. He began his theatrical life with Shakespeare playing Edgar in King Lear and Romeo in Romeo and Juliet and, in the dusk of his life, has been thrilled to be allowed to portray Lear, Prospero and other ripe characters, Peter has enjoyed the privilege of acting in over 150 stage and screen productions in Britain, Kuwait and Canada, ranging from ancient Greek drama on makeshift outdoor stages to new works and, sometimes, elaborate sets on film and stage. Having the director be your father and the lead actress as your mother worked well for Bowen considering the emotional truth required for this role. Bowen has also created his own language and loves to tell nonsensical stories, most focusing on trucks and boats. He has a life-long ban from ever viewing Latched but absolutely loves watching anything involving the Muppets.


