COLIN WEST (director, co-writer) is an award-winning director, producer, and screenwriter based in Los Angeles. He was an Annenberg Graduate MFA Fellow at the University of Southern California's School of Cinematic Arts. He's produced numerous short films, animations, and music videos, and has a slate of feature films in development including Survival Skills, the Stacy Keach starring feature film sponsored by MovieMaker Magazine and Film Independent. Upon graduating with a BFA from Ohio State University and working at the Billy Ireland Cartoon Library & Museum, he went on to work as a Multimedia Producer for MacArthur Award-winning visual artist Ann Hamilton, and then as a Producer for CBS Broadcasting. He's since produced for commercial film and television productions across Los Angeles and during his MFA program interned in Film & TV Development for Matt Reeve's (Director: Cloverfield, War for the Planet of the Apes) company, 6th & Idaho, in association with 20th Century Fox.

His short film We Were Not Made For This World, adapted from Eisner Award-winning cartoonist Paul Hornschemeier's comic of the same name, was shown internationally at film festivals and was awarded a Vimeo Staff Pick. His short film The Long Slow Flight of the Ashbot, a science fiction short adapted from Ignatz Award-winning cartoonist Joel Priddy, won the best science fiction short at the Berlin Short Film Festival. His films have screened internationally on the festival circuit and have been featured on Billboard, io9.com, GeekTyrant.com, LaughingSquid.com, FilmShortage.com, and CNET.com.

### DIRECTORS STATEMENT

Not far under the surface of this film is the story of my own grandfather and his wife. My grandpa was my grandma's caretaker for over 30 years as she battled Parkinson's disease. Since her death, and now almost 90 and in a nursing home, he struggles to remember names and faces and sometimes struggles to find even the most common, everyday words. Mixed with real stories, he tells us stories about places we're pretty sure he's never been and people we're pretty sure he's never met. But in the midst of all this, his memory of his wife has never faltered. The specificity of his recollections about her are remarkable and still so sharp among the blurring of the rest of his mind. With this film I was trying to find a way into his perspective — what it all must be like. This film is dedicated to him.
