## Katie Lemon, Writer/Director

Katie Lemon is a writer/director from Austin, Texas now based in Los Angeles. She is a graduate of the University of Southern California and is currently a third year directing MFA student at UCLA's School of Theater, Film and Television. At UCLA, she was the recipient of the 2018 Motion Picture Association of America (MPAA) Award and the 2019 Jean and Ruth Negulesco Endowment Fellowship.

Her first short film *Kin* earned an official selection at the HollyShorts Monthly Screening. Studio City International Film Festival, Los Angeles Lift-Off Film Festival and San Francisco Film Awards. In 2017, her short film *Welcome Home* was a finalist for the NewFilmmakers Los Angeles competition entitled *On Location: The Los Angeles Video Project.* Last year, her short documentary *James Tatum* screened at El Cid's female filmmaker night and the Newark International Film Festival. She is currently in post-production on her latest short film. *Sparklers*, which will be completed in early 2020.

## Greg Armstrong, DP

Originally from Northern Utah, Greg is a writer, director and editor based in Los Angeles. His award-winning narrative and documentary shorts have screened at film festivals like Slamdance, Atlanta International, Frameline, and many more. As an editor, he's received several awards and a Vimeo Staff Pick.

He's currently a Directing MFA candidate at UCLA, where he received the 2017 MPAA Award and the 2019 Jack Nicholson Distinguished Student Director Award.
