### Filmmaker's Biography:

Dr. **Teddy Alexis Rodriguez** was born in Ponce, Puerto Rico. Teddy attended the Bellas Artes (Fine Arts) High School of Ponce, Puerto Rico. Eventually, Rodriguez attended the University of Puerto Rico where he studied Theatre Arts and Theatre Education. During his teaching practicum he was awarded the Outstanding Practicing Teacher Award. During his tenure he directed and adapted Steve Galluccio's Mambo Italiano. The play enjoyed extended weekends run and the attendance of the president and dean of the University of Puerto Rico. Later, he obtained his doctorate in Fine Arts in Theatre with an emphasis in Directing/Acting. During my doctoral studies, I researched methods of multiculturalism in theatre and theatre education. That work was nominated for a Texas Tech University's Presidential Diversity and Equity Award. After that, Dr. Rodriguez moved to Los Angeles to pursue professional theatre and filmmaking. Most recently, he directed and wrote the piece "How did Edward Lose His Accent?" which advanced to semi-finals in the Short+Sweet, Hollywood LGBT Festival and it was awarded the Crew Award.

Currently, Rodriguez is having his Festival run of his film directorial debut "Hell No." The film has been nominated for several awards including Best Of Award Directing Award, Hollywood, Best Directorial Debut Canadian Cinematography Awards and has won several awards including IndieFest Award and Gold Star Movie Awards for Best


Short Film. Most recently, his original one act "Texas Transit" will be debuting on the Off Off Broadway Festival Triangle Gay Festival 2021.
