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LOGLINE

SYNOPSIS

Fighting for her last connection in a system designed to isolate her, pregnant Aria applies to an in-prison nursery program. She is determined to keep her baby close, stay sober, and turn her life around but when faced with a drug-dealing cellmate and a dehumanizing environment, Aria finds her dreams for the future are in constant peril.



DIRECTOR'S BIO

Jahmil Eady was raised in New York City and Charleston, SC. She earned her B.A. in Media Studies from Pomona College and studied film at the Prague Film School in the Czech Republic.

She worked as an associate producer on documentary projects for Oprah Winfrey Network, Viceland, and Discovery Network. Since transitioning into narrative screenwriting and directing, Jahmil has continued to create socially-minded character-driven stories. Her goal is not only to entertain but also to inspire, inform, and heal.

Jahmil's first short film, Heartland has screened at several Academy Qualifying Film Festivals including Santa Barbara International Film Festival (2021), Austin Film Festival (2021), St. Louis International Film Festival, and Black-Star Film Festival where it was nominated for the Starz Award for Best Speculative Fiction Short. Heartland won the Audience Choice Award at Indy Shorts International Film Festival (2021), and Best Live Action short at the Atlanta Sci-fi Film Festival.

Her most recent film, The Bond was fiscally sponsored by Film Independent and raised over \$26,000 on Kickstarter in just two weeks. Jahmil's awards include the New York Times Scholarship, Teri Schwartz Family and Friends Scholarship, and the Four Sisters Scholarship from writer-directors Gina Prince-Bythewood, Sara Finney-Johnson, Felicia D. Henderson, and Mara Brock Akil.

Jahmil is currently completing her MFA in Directing at UCLA School of Theater, Film and Television.



DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The Bond is inspired by my mother's experience giving birth to me while she was incarcerated. She tried to tell me her story when I was a teenager but I wasn't ready. At 29 years old, I sought her out and listen as she talked about giving birth under dehumanizing conditions. When she saw how angry I became, my mother took my hand and said, "It was Christmas. The officer probably wanted to get home to her own family instead of watching me cry." My mother's empathy inspired me and served as a north star as I researched, wrote, and directed this short.

Although the ugliness of mass incarceration is laid bare, this is not a film about prison nor is it a reenactment of my mother's ordeal. This is a story about the transformative power of empathy. *The Bond* also speaks to the broader human experiences of people impacted by mass incarceration; from mothers and children to medical professionals, and police officers.

In the film, various characters choose compassion and by doing so resist a powerful system designed to demean everybody involved. Through this film, I hope to spread the message that even in the bleakest and most divisive atmosphere, bonds of empathy can give us the power to persevere.

Ashley Wilkerson is an award-winning, theatrically trained, actress, poet, and wellness practitioner from Dallas, Texas. Her principal roles include the indie hit, Hunter Gatherer, The Mountaintop (Jubilee Theater), Mississippi Goddamn (world premiere, SDCC), and her one-woman show "Freckle in My Eye," which toured nationally. As the founder of Brother Breathe, Ashley created trauma-informed, mindfulness-based workshops. She's worked extensively with crime survivors, veterans, juveniles on probation, and incarcerated girls and women. She is passionate about using art for personal and societal healing.



Yolonda Ross is an American actress, writer and director. She is recognized for her wide range of work in film, television and stage, including: Cheryl Dunye's Stranger Inside, Angela Bassett's Whitney, Denzel Washington's Antwone Fisher Story, and David Mamet's The Unit, and Phil Spector. Yolonda has recurred in How To Get Away With Murder, The Get Down, and Treme, which inspired her directorial debut, Breaking Night. Ross also plays series regular, Jada, on the Lena Waithe critically-acclaimed Showtime series, The Chi.

She is best known for her role as Alexandra Eames on Law & Order: Criminal Intent, a spin-off of Law & Order, and Shirley Bellinger in the HBO series Oz.
