VISION STATEMENT

The film was first conceptualized after the director witnessed a shooting with his little brother, and with the writer, that experience was expanded into a story to highlight the mental health of young Black men coping with death among other injustices in their community.

Funded entirely out of the Director's pockets and captured entirely by a 1 - 3 person crew, the Director also shot and edited the film himself.

Despite doubts and discouraging circumstances, both the director and writer were employed to trust their visions, and the production ultimately became much bigger than them and a testament to their persistence as creatives and storytellers within their communities.








