About the Film

In January 2020, Eliana Pipes was awarded the inaugural WAVE Grant from Wavelength Productions, designed to support emerging female filmmakers of color.

¡Nails! was initially conceived as a live-action short film, based on one of her stage plays. But when the COVID-19 pandemic halted production indefinitely, she had to either abandon the project or reinvent it.


Pipes decided to pivot and re-imagined ¡Nails! for animation. With no previous experience in the form, she rewrote the script as a no-dialogue animation, storyboarded over 250 frames, and partnered with her high school friend and character designer Revel Rosa to bring the project to life.



Eliana Pipes is a playwright, filmmaker, and Angelino. She's been awarded the Academy Gold Fellowship for Women, Kennedy Center Harold and Mimi Stienberg Prize, Leah Ryan Fund prize, National Latinx Playwriting Award, and the WAVE Grant.

Her play DREAM HOU\$E received a world premiere triple coproduction at The Alliance Theater, Long Wharf Theater, and Baltimore Center Stage. Her plays have been developed or presented at Second Stage, The Playwright's Realm, NNPN, South Coast Repertory, Ars Nova ANT Fest, and more. She was a member of the 20/21 Dramatist Guild Foundation Fellowship.

She's a board member and proud 4th grade alum of YoungStorytellers. She holds a BA in English from Columbia University, and an MFA in Playwriting from Boston University.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Where was the film produced?

The ¡Nails! process was entirely remote due to the pandemic, so the team was collaborating across the country from Los Angeles to New York to Atlanta.

How was diversity on the production team?

Of the 14 members of the core crew, 10 are BIPOC artists, 7 are women, and 7 are LGBTQ+. In total, our crew was 50% or more BIPOC, female, and LGBTQ+.

How long did the process take?

The initial live-action short film was in pre-production beginning In January 2020, then re-conceived and re-scripted as an animation beginning in August 2020. Pre-production for the animation began in December 2020 and production for the animation began In May 2021 and wrapped In September 2021.
