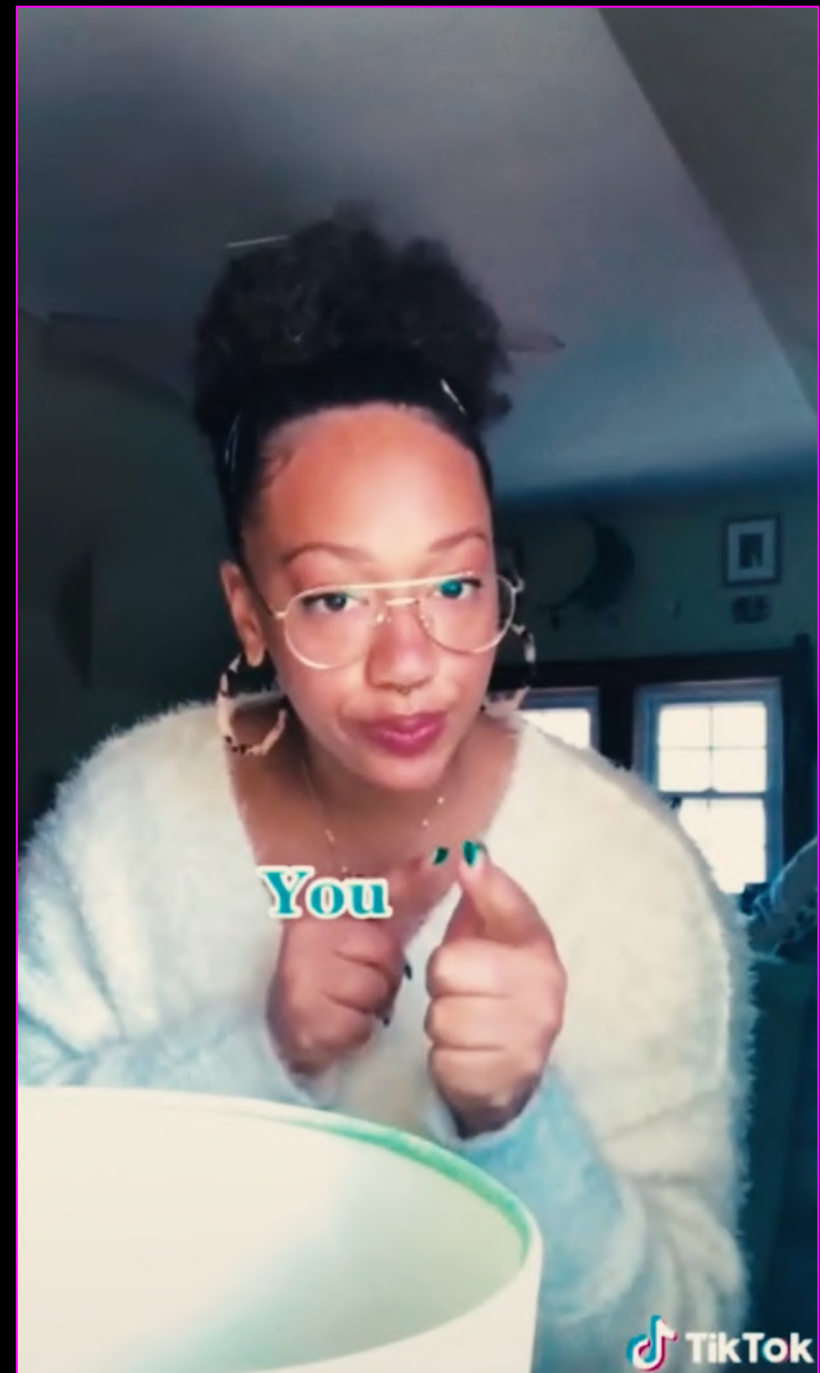

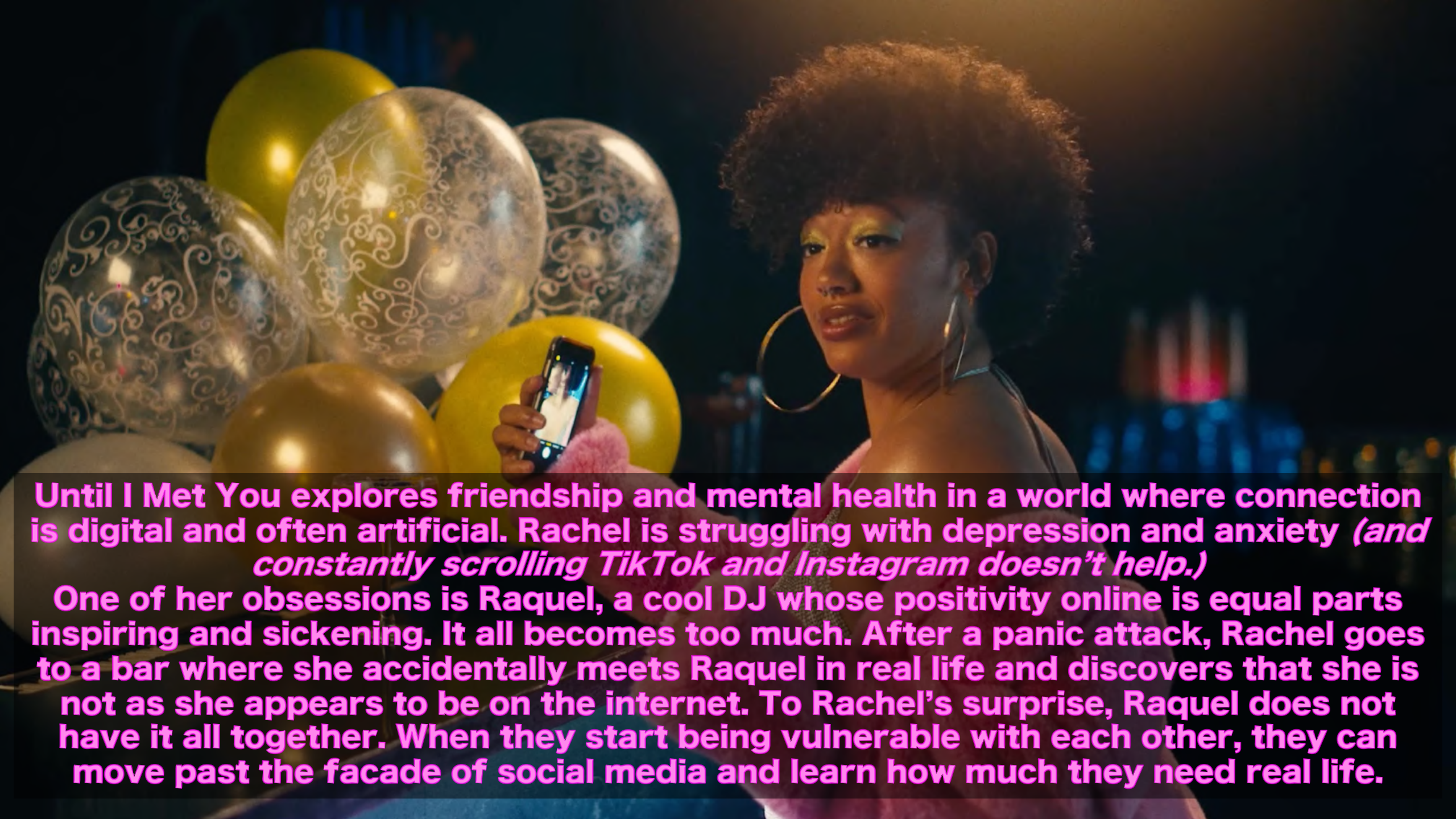

Until I Met You explores friendship and mental health in a world where connection is digital and often artificial. Rachel is struggling with depression and anxiety (*and constantly scrolling TikTok and Instagram doesn't help.*)

One of her obsessions is Raquel, a cool DJ whose positivity online is equal parts inspiring and sickening. It all becomes too much. After a panic attack, Rachel goes to a bar where she accidentally meets Raquel in real life and discovers that she is not as she appears to be on the internet. To Rachel's surprise, Raquel does not have it all together. When they start being vulnerable with each other, they can move past the facade of social media and learn how much they need real life.

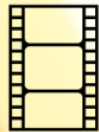
