## **SUMMARY**

Leveraging a conversational soundtrack and meticulously woven visual metaphors, The Future Is Worn portrays Sol's inner turmoil, her interactions with the evasive entity, and her eventual acceptance for who she has become.

The short film explores themes of identity, trauma, the transformative power of genuine connections, and self-love. It proposes that within every struggle is an opportunity for deep personal growth; that these moments tell us not only who we are but what we truly need.







Ken Lasoul Jones, a 24-year-old multi-hyphenated performance artist from Los Angeles, CA, began her artistic journey young, exploring physical and visual arts driven by a deep emotional connection to beauty.

She's a self-taught painter, writer, and actor, but started her dance career later than most. Despite this, she earned a year-long pre-professional scholarship at Hollywood's Edge Performing Arts Center, studying various dance styles for up to 40 hours a week.
