






Director's Statement

This story is based on the real-life experience of a friend who returned to Argentina after living in Europe. We recently reunited, and over drinks, I asked her what had happened. I never imagined that the reason she came back to our country was the need to undergo an abortion. At first, I felt very sad for not having known earlier, but even more sorrow engulfed me when she told me that, apart from undergoing a very secretive and lonely process, the doctor who performed the abortion, far from sympathizing with her pain, judged her. Then, I felt a strong desire to have been there for her; to have been able to lend a helping hand so she wouldn't feel alone in this challenging moment. I imagined that she wasn't the only one, and I felt a desire to capture in images the wish to be there for all those women who have faced a similar situation in solitude. This short film doesn't necessarily revolve around abortion, and it is indifferent to whether we are in favor of its legality or not. I feel that it is inhumanly cruel when a person, instead of trying to alleviate the pain of another, stops to judge them. That's why this short film is about empathy and sisterhood.





Director I Producer

Sofia Rovaletti is an Argentine filmmaker and executive who, after diverse roles in film production, documentaries, advertising, live events, and theater, found her niche in development. She studied filmmaking at the Eliseo Subiela Film School and the National University of the Arts in Argentina. Sofia participated in the production of notable films like "Operation Finale," directed by Chris Weitz, and the Argentine masterpiece "Zama," directed by Lucrecia Martel. In Argentina, she worked with production companies Rei Cine, Landia, Brava Cine, and Marlon, and was part of the production team for the Youth Olympic Games Opening Ceremony Buenos Aires 2018. Since her move to Los Angeles in 2019, Sofia has worked with sales agency Shoreline Entertainment and currently serves as the Director of Development at MoJo Global Arts, developing films, TV series, and docuseries with renowned talents. In 2024, she produced the feature film "Tender" starring Jesse Garcia (Flammin' Hot), David Koechner (Anchorman), Shakira Barrera (Glow), and Jess Weixler (Teeth). In 2025, she produced the short film "I F*cking Hate You", directed by Gabriela Paciel and part of the fellowship by The Latino Film Institute and Netflix.

In 2022 and 2023, she performed in the play "Retorcijones", in Buenos Aires. In December 2022, she performed and co-wrote "Navidad Espacial", a production by the Embassy of Colombia in Argentina. In 2023, she starred in and wrote "The Interpreter" in New York. The short film premiered at the Los Angeles Latino International Film Festival (LALIFF), and was also selected for the San Diego Latino Film Festival in California, Femme Frontera in Texas, the Alicante Film Festival 2025 (Spain), Ciudad Real Festival (Spain), and most recently, Tucuman Cine Festival (Argentina).
