


Director's Statement:

Creative Team



Director/Producer

Justin O. Cooper is a Los Angeles-based filmmaker and founder of JOCMedia & Entertainment. He directed and produced the Oscar-qualifying documentary *CIRILO*, *A Legacy Untold*, which has screened at international festivals including Diversity in Cannes, Seattle Latino Film Festival, and the Detroit Black Film Festival. Cooper also consults for the Royal Film Commission - Jordan, liaising with Hollywood productions filmed in the Kingdom such as *Aladdin* and *Dune: Part One*. A former film liaison in Georgia and ASCAP Plus Award-winning writer, his career bridges film, music, and global production.



Narrator/ Executive Producer

Ann Nesby is a two-time Grammy Award-winning singer, actress, and songwriter with a celebrated career spanning music, film, television, and theater. She serves as narrator and executive producer of *CIRILO*, *A Legacy Untold*, and contributed the powerful song "We Rise" featuring the Sounds of Blackness to the film's soundtrack. A former lead vocalist of the legendary Sounds of Blackness, Nesby has also appeared in feature films such as *The Fighting Temptations*, acclaimed television series including *Queen Sugar* and *Atlanta*, and the Broadway production *Tina - The Tina Turner Musical*. Known for her powerhouse voice and commanding stage presence, she continues to inspire audiences worldwide through her artistry and storytelling.



Director of Photography

Jeffrey Gabriel Silva is a Chicago-based, award-winning filmmaker and director of photography. His work has screened internationally at festivals including the Chicago Latino Film Festival, Seattle Latino Film Festival, PROOF in Los Angeles, and the Ícaro Film Festival in Guatemala. A versatile visual storyteller, Silva brings a cinematic eye shaped by global influences and independent film traditions. He holds an MFA in Film and Television Directing from DePaul University.

Maverick "Baby T" Turner is a two-time Emmy Award-winning sound designer, composer, and audio mixing engineer. 
