DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT - JESSICA SANDERS

"I Want To Feel Fun" began as a creative experiment— Could I make a fully improvised film without a script, drawing on my background as a documentary filmmaker and comedy director, collaborating with an incredible cast. The idea was sparked when I saw comedian Esther Povitsky's Nicki Minaj shower curtain—and soon after learned Nicki was performing at the Staples Center.

Taking a docu-style approach, in the spirit of Scorsese's *After Hours*, the film follows Esther as she tries to get into the Nicki Minaj concert. Along the way, we meet Simon Rex—Esther's non-boyfriend—her brother, played by Avi Rothman, and Avi's longtime girlfriend, played by Vivian Bang.

My approach to the comedy was to work closely with the cast, amplifying exaggerated truths and surround them with non-actors, crafting an adventure through Los Angeles in search of love, connection and Nicki Minaj.

ABOUT JESSICA SANDERS Writer/Director/Producer



Jessica Sanders is an Academy Award – nominated, Sundance and Cannes Award – winning director and producer of narrative and documentary films and commercials.

Jessica's latest short film "I Want to Feel Fun" is an improvised comedy that will World Premiere at the 2025 Tribeca Festival. Jessica directed, produced and wrote the martial arts action short film "The Cocktail Party" which premiered at the 2021 Tribeca Festival. The action packed, playful film tells the story of a cocktail party that turns into an unexpected martial arts action film.

Jessica directed and executive produced the TV pilot "Embrace" which won the 2020 SXSW Film Festival Grand Jury Prize and

premiered at the 2020 Sundance Film Festival.

Jessica directed and produced the short film "End of the Line" which premiered at the 2018 Sundance Film Festival. The visual effects heavy film is based on a short story by acclaimed writer Aimee Bender, exploring themes of power and its abuse. Staring Brett Gelman (Fleabag) and Simon Helberg (Big Bang Theory), for Refinery29 and TNT's Anthology Shatterbox film series.

Jessica's first feature documentary film "After Innocence" which she directed, wrote and produced tells the moving story of innocent men wrongfully imprisoned for decades and exonerated after DNA testing proved their innocence. The film won the Sundance Special Jury Prize and numerous festival awards before being released theatrically by New Yorker Films and

premiering on Showtime. It was shortlisted for the Academy Awards and became a game changer in criminal justice reform, bringing awareness and change for the wrongfully convicted.

Jessica's award-winning commercial career was launched when Steve Jobs handpicked her to direct Apple's iPad launch campaign. Jessica won the coveted Cannes Young Director's Award for her "Sony Make.Believe" film which also won an AICP award. Jessica's work can be seen at: www.jessicasandersfilm.com

ESTHER POVITSKY is an American stand-up comedian, actress, writer, and producer. Most recently she co-wrote and starred in the feature *Drugstore June*. Povitsky is the co-creator and star of the comedy series *Alone Together* (2018); she starred as Izzy in the Hulu series *Dollface*. Her debut comedy special, *Hot for My Name*, premiered on Comedy Central. Other television appearances include *Crazy Ex-Girlfriend*, *Brooklyn Nine-Nine*, *Love*, and *Parks and Recreation*. AVI ROTHMAN previously collaborated with filmmaker Jessica Sanders as a writer and actor on the award-winning comedy short film *Bunion* (2014). SIMON REX is an American actor and rapper. In 2021, Simon received critical acclaim for his lead role in Sean Baker's drama film *Red Rocket*, winning the Independent Spirit Award for Best Male Lead. Recently Rex was in Zoe Kravitz' directorial debut *Blink Twice* and is in the Sundance-premiered film *Magic Farm*. Rising to fame as an MTV VJ, Rex later became an actor known for *What I Like About You*, starring in three films of the *Scary Movie* franchise, and *National Lampoon's Pledge This!*. He later developed a rap persona, Dirt Nasty, and had several solo albums and co-founded the hip-hop group Three Loco.



VIVIAN BANG starred in *White Rabbit*, which she also wrote, directed by Daryl Wein, which premiered at Sundance Film Festival in 2018. Vivian was a main cast member on television shows *Sullivan & Son* and *Swedish Dicks*. She had notable minor film roles as a bridal shower planner in *Yes Man* (2008) and the hippie girlfriend in *Always Be My Maybe* (2019). Recently she is in the film *The Parenting*.



DUGAN O'NEAL is a writer and commercial and film director, known for Dream Corp LLC (2016), Stupid Hype (2013) and L.A. Rangers (2013)
