This was an incredibly difficult project for me to create, as it deals with the subject of death—and my own father passed away while I was making it. Over the course of more than 1,600 hours of labor, I poured myself into this fully stop-motion animated music video for Lena Hall, whose trust and collaboration I am deeply grateful for. It is hard to say no to a Tony Award winner, Grammy nominee, and the star of Apple TV's Your Friends and Neighbors—but more importantly, Lena is my friend.

In an uncanny twist of fate, Lena's father also passed away during the making of this film.

Together, we chose to dedicate the project to our dads, channeling grief into art. The dolls, the Grim Reaper, and the endless cycle at the heart of the film became not only a darkly comic narrative, but also a reflection of the real cycles of loss and remembrance we were living through.



This project became more than just animation; it became a way to honor our parents, to find meaning through creation, and to laugh, even if painfully, at the inevitability of death. It has truly been a hell of a year—but also one of profound gratitude.

Oliver Anderson is a globally award-winning filmmaker whose work reimagines stop-motion animation through playful yet poignant toy-inspired worlds and colorful, creature--characters. LENA HALL is a Tony Award winner and Grammy nominee who currently stars on the hit Apple TV+ series "Your Friends and Neighbors" opposite Jon Hamm and Olivia Munn and can be seen in Ethan Coen's "Honey Don't" in theaters now. Hall received widespread critical acclaim for hi performance of the title role in the feature film Becks, (winner of the U.S. Fiction Award at the L.A. Film Festival) and starred as Miss Audrey in the TNT hit sci-fi drama "Snowpiercer" for 4 seasons alongside Academy Award winner Jennifer Connelly. She has guest starred on HBO's "Girls," Amazon Prime's "Good Girls Revolt." and Paramount Plus' "Evil." Following her Tony-winning Broadway run in Hedwig and the Angry Inch, Lena toured North America with Josh Groban on his "Stages" tour, and portrayed the dual starring roles of both Hedwig and Yitzhak in Hedwig and the Angry Inch in Los Angeles and San Francisco. Lena originated the role of Nicola in Kinky Boots on Broadway, starred opposite Academy Award winner Marisa Tomei in Lincoln Center Theatre's "How To Transcend A Happy Marriage," and starred as Audrey in the hit revival of "Little Shop Of Horrors," among others. Lena's solo shows Sin & Salvation (Cafe Carlyle), Art Of The Audition (Cafe Carlyle), and The Villa Satori: Growing up Haight Ashbury, played sold-out across the US. Her albums can be downloaded on all streaming platforms including her newest EP "Songs From Your Friends and Neighbors". Lena was a guest artist performing in select shows with Rob Thomas on his current 2025 solo tour, "All Night Days"
